Training Course on ISO 17024

As a preparation for accreditation of Malaysian National Certifying Body for NDT, a special 2 days training course on ISO 17024 was organized by the Department of Skill Development (DSD), Ministry of Human Resource in ESSET Bangi on 19th and 20th February 2008. The main objective of this course is to provide an early exposure to all individuals within NCB that are expected to be part of the accreditation program. In addition to DSD personnel, the course was also attended by special guests representing MSNT, Atomic Energy Licensing Board, Ruanne TATI and SIRIM Bhd.

MSNT is planning to organize an International Seminar on NDT for Plant and Structural Integrity in 2009. Two organizations namely ASCOPE (Asean Council on Petroleum) and INSTEP (Institut Teknologi Petroleum PETRONAS) was identified by the Board of Directors as the possible co-organizers for this seminar. Separate meetings were held between the Society's representative with representatives from ASCOPE (at PRSS, Bangi) and INSTEP (at Menara Dayabumi Kuala Lumpur), specifically to discuss about the possibility of co-organizing this seminar, were held on 28th February and 6th March respectively. The official outcome of this meeting is yet to be announced. However representatives of both organizations were very positive that this collaboration would get the approval from their respective organization.

During the meeting, members of Committee agreed that the course will be held at the Malaysian Nuclear Agency while experts and participants will be accommodated at Kajang Metro Inn Hotel through the period of this course.
