Due to increasing demand for Malaysian Skills Certificate in NDT from industries, the NDT Certification Unit of Department of Skills Development (DSD) as the National Certification Body (NCB) is organising a road show to promote the scheme.

The first series which took place on 21st May 2014 was jointly organised with UniKL MFI, Bangi. Five speakers, 2 from the NCB, 1 from Malaysia Airlines System, 1 from Nuclear Malaysia and 1 from the Society present their papers during this event. Almost 100 students and lecturers were participating in the half-day talk session.

As a part of efforts to improve Malaysian training and certification system for NDT, the Department of Skill Development as the National Certification Body has organized a three days workshop on the development of training materials in accordance with the NOSS. The workshop has been conducted at di Avillion Admiral Cove Hotel, Port Dickson. It was participated by 20 individuals representing NDT training agencies accredited by the NCB .

A group of 30 students and a lecturer from Sultan Idris Education University visited NDT laboratories at the Malaysian Nuclear Agency. Similarly another group of 55 student alongwith 2 lecturers from the International Islamic University visited the same laboratories on 19th March 2014. The objectives of these visits were to give the opportunity to the student from both universities to observe activities particularly in research and development in the area of non-destructive testing and trainings. During this visit, students were given guided to visit radiography (including digital radiography), eddy current, surface methods and ultrasonic laboratories. Questions and answers session provided at the end of the visit enabled the student to update their knowledge and experience on various aspects related to this technology.
