Advancing Occupational Structure: NDT Excellence under ISO 9712

In conjunction with the 7th Malaysia International Non-Destructive Testing Conference and Exhibition (MINDTCE) held at Sunway Resort Hotel, the Industrial Engagement Programme 2024 (IEP 2024) was successfully conducted on 19 August 2024. Organized by the Division of Occupational Standards and TVET Curriculum (BSPKTVET) in collaboration with the Malaysian Society for Non-Destructive Testing (MSNT). recognized Industry Lead Body for Non-Destructive Testing, this year's program centered around the was theme "Advancing Occupational Structures: NDT Excellence Under ISO 9712."

En. Wan Abdullah bin Hamat of PETRONAS shared insights through his "Beyond Standard - Petronas Quest for



Competent NDT Personnel" session while En. Alamin bin Pardi from Epic Aero presented "Setting Standard Sky-High: The Need for Malaysia's Aerospace NDT Certification Scheme." Additionally, Pn. Salbiah Hussein from BSPKTVET provided valuable information on the Occupational Framework (OF), NOSS, and SKM NDT certifications and their connection to ISO 17024 and ISO 9712 in her talk titled "Enhancing Excellence: OF, NOSS, and SKM in the NDT Industry."

The afternoon session featured a dynamic forum on "NDT Certification: Global Perspectives and Industry Insights" by Dr. Mohd Noorul Ikhsan. The session saw active participation with discussions on elevating SKM NDT certification standards in Malaysia through OF and NOSS, as well as addressing challenges faced by JPK in aligning SKM NDT certifications with international standards.



Dr. Ilham Mukriz, President of MSNT, officially closed the IEP 2024. The event saw an attendance of nearly 150 participants, and it is anticipated that the knowledge and experiences shared during the program will significantly benefit all involved, particularly those within the NDT industry.



Geographic Distribution of Visitors

The geographic distribution of visitors at the 7th MINDTCE showcased its truly international appeal, with the majority coming from Asia, led by Malaysia with 1,209 attendees.


Other Asian countries such as Singapore, Indonesia, India, and Brunei Darussalam also had notable participation. Visitors from Africa, including countries like Cameroon, Egypt, and Nigeria, added to the diversity, along with attendees from Europe, Australia, and South America. This global representation underscores the event's significance and broad appeal across various regions and industries.

Industry Sector Representation

Visitors to the 7th MINDTCE came from a diverse array of industry sectors, highlighting the broad application of NDT technologies. The largest contingent was from the Oil and Gas sector, making up 43.4% of attendees, which underscores the critical importance of NDT in ensuring safety and reliability in this industry.

Visitors's Job Role

The 7th MINDTCE attracted a diverse group of professionals, reflecting the cross-disciplinary nature of NDT technologies. Executives made up the largest group, accounting for 34.7% of visitors, followed by Lecturers at 19.4%, and Sales Engineers at 14.3%. Managers comprised 11.2% of attendees, while CEOs and Directors together represented 6.1%.




The Manufacturing Fabrication and sector accounted for 17.9% of visitors, followed closely by the Petrochemical, Chemical, or Process Industry at 17.1%, and the Education sector at 15.8%. Additionally. 9.9% of attendees represented the Construction Infrastructure sector, while 9.2% came from Power Generation. This strong representation across key industries emphasizes the essential role of NDT in maintaining standards and advancing technology in these areas.

This variety of job roles underscores the widespread relevance and importance of NDT technologies across multiple professional domains

Visitors' Types of Services

Visitors to the 7th MINDTCE showed a strong interest in various NDT-related services and products, with 31.2% affiliated with inspection companies, either conventional, advanced, or both, making this the most sought-after service.




Consulting and engineering services also attracted significant attention, with 21.6% of visitors representing these sectors.

Training centers accounted for 15% of the audience, while 9.2% were connected to equipment distributors and 6.2% to equipment manufacturers. Certification bodies made up 5.4% of visitors.


This distribution highlights the critical importance of inspection services and consulting/engineering services within the NDT industry.

Visitors' type of Organization

Visitors to the 7th MINDTCE represented a wide range of organizational types, highlighting the event's broad appeal.



The majority, 65.8%, were from private companies, indicating strong industry interest in NDT technologies. Government entities accounted for 25.6% of visitors, while 7.8% came from Government Linked Companies (GLCs). Additionally, 4.8% were from government-owned institutions, and 0.8% from statutory bodies. This significant participation from both private and public sectors underscores the vital role of NDT technologies across various domains, including public sector projects.

The 7th MINDTCE was a resounding success, attracting a diverse group of visitors from around the world and across various industries. The strong international presence, combined with the wide range of industry sectors represented, highlights the global significance of the event and its critical role in advancing NDT technologies.
